*Level 5 accepted for Photography and Graphics

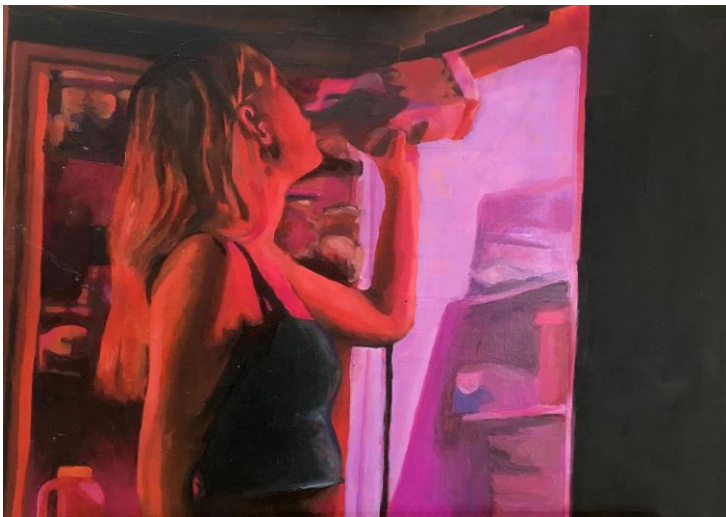
A Level Course Structure

- 60% = Coursework (*Personal Investigation – you set this project yourself*).
- 40% = Exam project, including 15 hours practical exam, sat in April of Year 13.
- 2 year course.

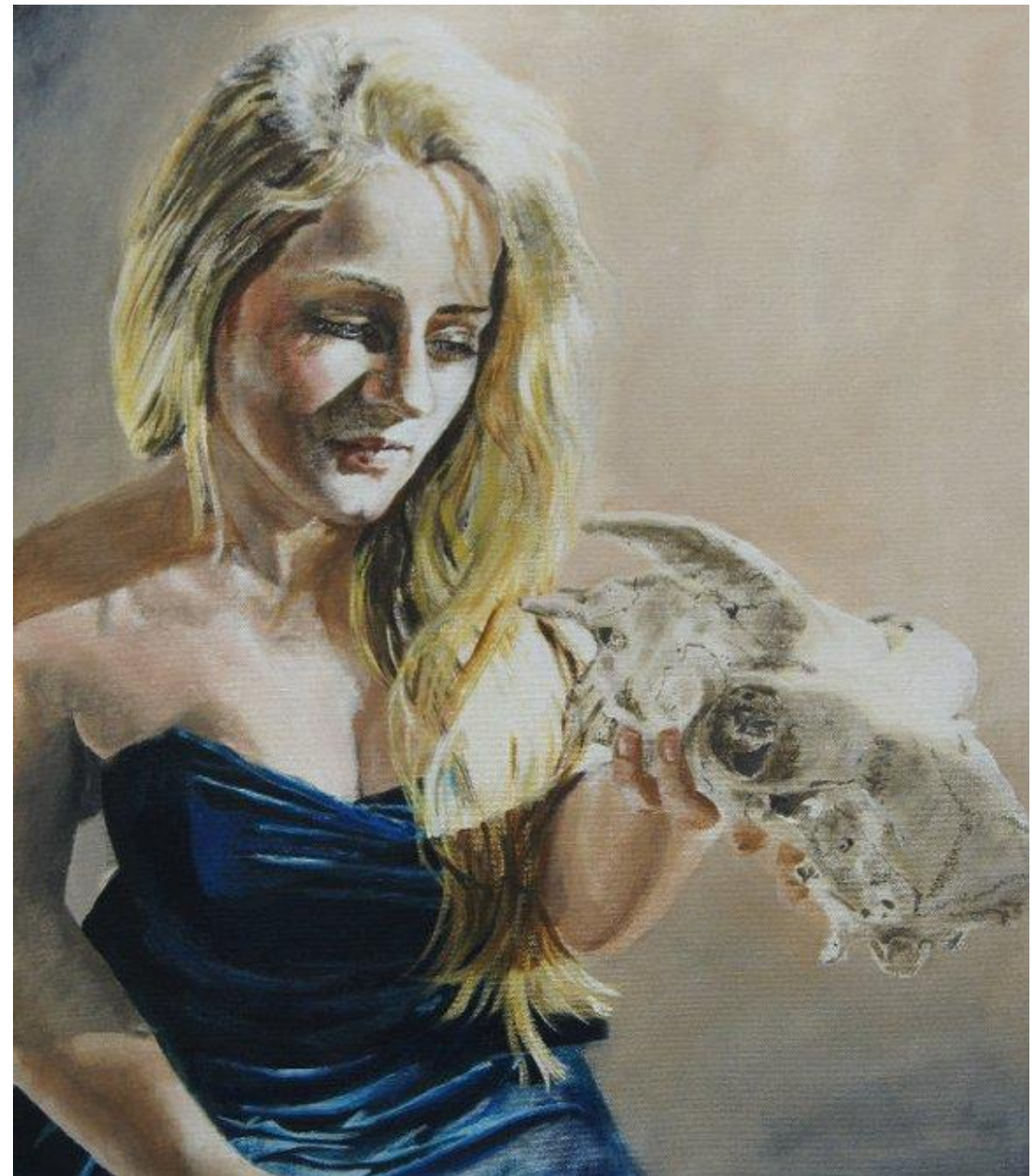
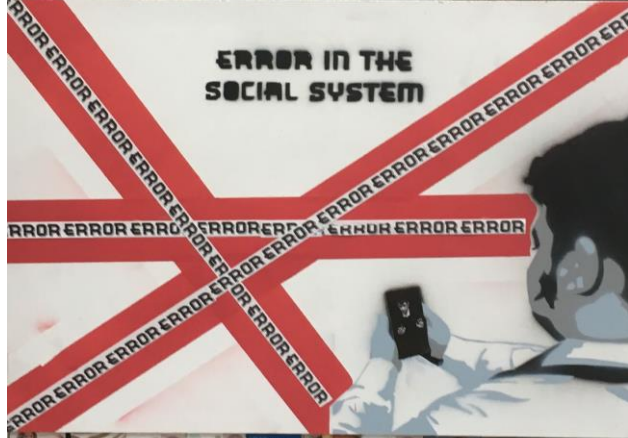

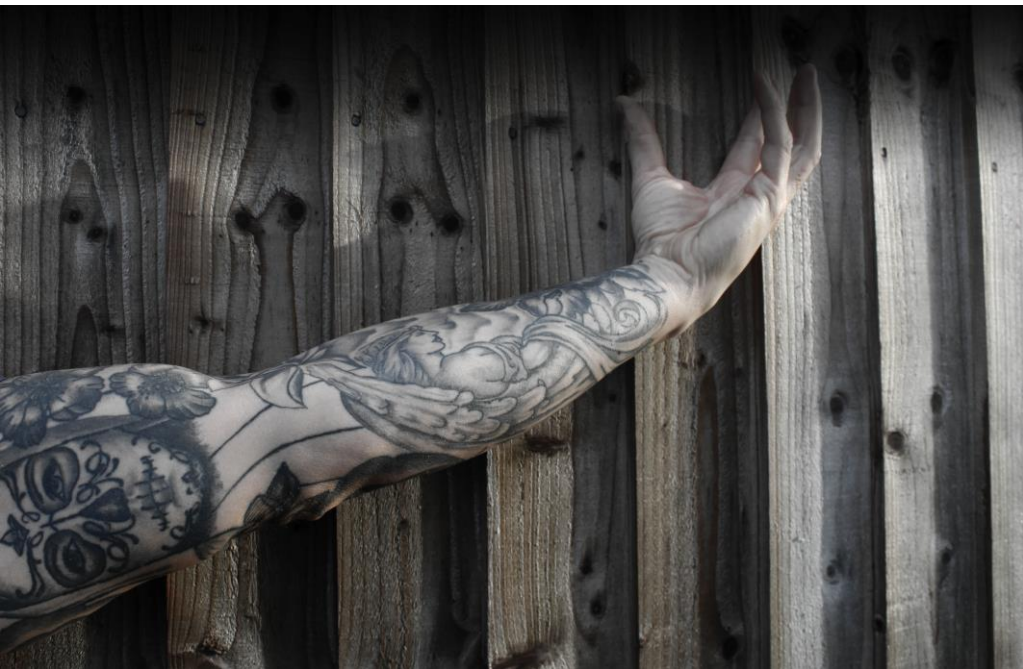
